The Akita International Association (AIA) engages in the following activities:

~Contributing to building multicultural communities through international exchange~

In order to enable residents of the prefecture regardless of their nationality to live together with peace of mind as members of the local communities, while understanding and respecting each other's different cultural backgrounds, we are developing various initiatives related to international exchange. And it is also one of our key priorities to promote Japanese language education for international residents.

We are working to promote smooth communication between prefectural and international residents.

- (1) Promoting multilingual services and improving the consultation system
 - Establishment and operation of a consultation center for foreign residents (Akita Prefectural Support Center for Foreign Nationals)
 - Providing resources such as lifestyle information in multiple languages and simplified Japanese, and through a diverse range of media
- (2) Promotion of Japanese language education
 - Enhancing opportunities for foreign residents to learn Japanese, etc.



We are working on initiatives to train personnel involved in supporting international residents and to prepare for disaster response.

- (1) Securing and developing personnel to support international people
 - Providing Japanese language supporters and other volunteers, as well as conducting training and other activities.
- (2) Strengthening of support systems during disasters
 - Creation and distribution of disaster relief supplies
 - Providing appropriate information during disasters and establishing a communication and cooperation system with relevant organizations



We are working to contribute to raising awareness and revitalizing local communities by creating places and opportunities for interaction.

- (1) Raising awareness regarding multicultural coexistence
 - Applications of interns for high school and college students
 - Holding of International Days
- (2) Support for exchange activities related to multicultural coexistence
 - Holding of the Akita International Festival
 - Operation of the International Activities Grant Program
